Courses: Lead King Loop 25K The 25K dirt road course starts you in the quaint and historic town of Marble. Rounding Beaver Lake, you climb 2900 vertical feet in about 4 miles into beautiful Lead King Basin Travers at 10000 feet, then roll down past waterfalls, through the old mining town of Crystal, pass the famous 110-year-old Crystal Mill, climb out of the river valley then scream back down to the finish line.

Quarry Climb 12.5K The 12.5K dirt road course starts at the Beaver Lake Lodge and winds through Marble until crossing the Crystal River. The course then climbs 1000 feet through a beautiful aspen grove to the base of the marble quarry. Return downhill to the finish with amazing vistas of the valley and Yule creek.

Lake Kids Loop 1.25M 2nd year of race starting at the Lodge and looping around marble and scenic Beaver Lake

Directions: From Glenwood Springs take Highway 82 south to Carbondale. Turn onto HWY 133 then travel around 25 miles to the “Marble Turnoff” County Road 3. Turn Left. Follow the signs about 8 miles through town to the Beaver Lake Lodge.

Awards, Prizes, Raffle each runner will receive a tech shirt, pint glass, as well as a great goody bag. Awards will given to the top 3 finishers overall.
